Guests

Guests All guests must pay guest fees upon entering the campground and register at the office. Campers wishing to pay for guests must prepay guest fees. Daily guest fees are \$8 for ages 2 to adult. An additional \$7 is assessed for guests staying overnight. Season passes can be purchased at the office for \$200 per person. A \$75 two-week pass can be purchased for guests staying with campers for up to 2 consecutive weeks. Daytime guests must leave the camp by quiet time. Campers are responsible for the actions of their guests and must make them aware of all rules and policies. Guests are not permitted on the campground property without their host present. Any camper whose guests did not pay guest fees are subject to immediate expulsion without refund and without further warning or notice. Guests are not permitted to bring their dogs to camp.
