## A Closing Up Checklist

Including this weekend, we have 3 glorious weekends of camping left this season. For those of you who choose to pack it in early and say goodbye to your camping friends, we have a checklist of items we would like you to consider when preparing your campsite for the winter:

- Detach hookups from water and electric (we will shut down electric this winter)
  but do not remove the antisyphon valve from the water spigot
- Winterize your RV water system or sign up for winterization
- Disable and cover your golf cart or remove it from the property
- Put away decorations and personal items on your site to prevent damage and allow for spring clean-up, especially if you are hiring LLC to clean up your leaves
- Remove kayaks, canoes and SUPs from racks by the water and store under camper, on deck or take home
- Sign up for site cleaning with the office if you wish to hire LLC to do it for you.
- Tip picnic table on its side with 1 bench to the ground
- Sign up and pay for boat storage if your boat will be here beyond October 9.
