Please give us a paper copy of the liability insurance and make sure the following is on the paperwork: your name, dates of coverage, \$100,000 liability insurance and that the policy spells out it covers a golf cart.

Wi-Fi Connections

Presently we cannot offer the use of the adult rec hall computer as there is no access to our buildings. There is a table and chairs outside the adult rec hall so you can access the wi-fi from your own lap top or device with the user name adult lounge and the password "laurellock." Outside the rec hall area use the user name ASUS with the password "15cottageroad." Campers wanting a wi-fi connection at their campsite can call Frontier at 219-869-7392 and give them the name of camp and your site number. You will receive a separate invoice from Frontier. There will be a limited number of wi-fi access lines available throughout the campground. Another option is to purchase a hotspot device through a device provider that is portable for you take anywhere.
