Work Orders, Purchases and Payments

All maintenance requests, orders for firewood, stone and payments to the campground must be recorded in the office. Spraying for poison ivy will begin soon. If you see this shiny 3-leaf vine growing in or around your campsite, please let the office know.

Propane

Propane tanks for fill up at our pump station that are left in the drop-off area by 3 pm will be filled by 6 pm. Please make sure your site # and/or name are on your tanks. Prepaying for your fill up will insure your tank is left in the pick-up area after filling. If you need propane outside of our pumping schedule, a loaner tank may be available at no additional charge. Please inquire in the office for a loaner tank. If you have an old tank for disposal, there is a \$10 fee.

Golf Cart Tire

Whom ever dropped off a golf cart tire for disposal, you may come and get it. We can not dispose of tires.
