# Tips From Theresa At Road Tech RV

There are big differences between insurance policies and extended warrantees out there. Know what they do and do not cover. One warranty item many RV owners find out about the hard way is that ANY water damage almost always falls under "routine maintenance" and usually isn't covered.
