
August 1, 11 a.m. - Golf Cart Rally

Two Dog Incidents Brings New Rules For Dogs At Camp

Dogs are to <u>always</u> be leashed on golf carts, at sites and when walking around camp. The only time dogs should be off leash on campground property is at the boat field or when they are actively using the boat launch for swimming. If you know your dog has aggressive tendencies, your dog should <u>never</u> be off leash at camp. Warnings will be issued for any incident involving aggressive dogs and after one warning, if a second incident is reported, reported dog will not be allowed to be at camp.
