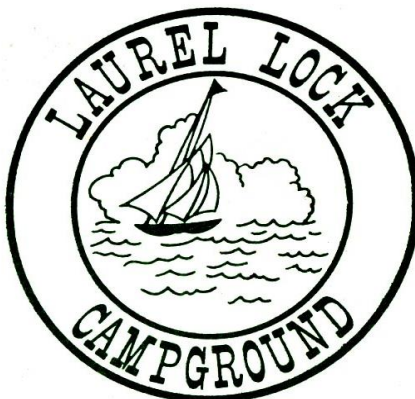
Fiber-Optic '24 - YES or NO
