Entrance To Boat Field

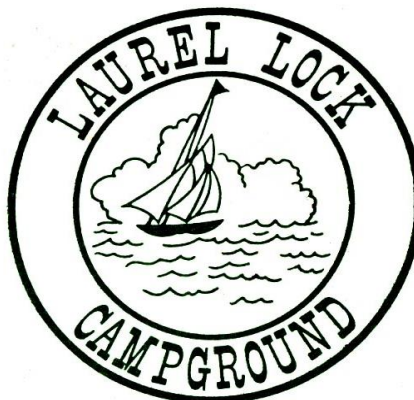
