Monthly Payments

Those campers who would like to pay monthly payments, starting November 1st, for their 2021 campsite must sign up in the camp office. Your winter storage, electric bills and any outstanding invoices must be paid separately in advance of starting the monthly payment plan. Ask in the camp office about adjusting your payment plan. If you were on the monthly payment plan last year, you must again sign up this year, or we will assume you now wish to make the regular three payments in February, April and June.

Mandatory Golf Cart Numbering

As a reminder, all golf carts need to be numbered with your campsite number. In the past we have required 3” numbers but going forward we require **4” numbers**. Two sets of 4” numbers are to be placed either on the front and back or both sides. This rule is for every cart no matter how distinctive your cart looks. Any cart not numbered by Labor Day weekend, will need to be removed from the property, or numbered by LLPM staff and billed to the camper.

Swimming Within Buoy Lines

Parents please remind your children to stay within the swimming area buoy lines. This pertains to all swimmers even when they have a float of any kind.

Campsite Move Requests

Any seasonal camper who would like to request a move to another campsite, please let the office know now before we allocate sites to new campers coming in for 2021.
