Anti-Syphon Valves

Please leave the anti-syphon valve attached to your faucet after removing your hose for the winter. Any camper removing the anti-syphon valve will be charged a fee.

Paddling Boats

Paddlers have until the close of camp to enjoy their boats. By closing day though, we need all paddle vessels removed from the racks. Please remove them from camp or place them on your deck or under your RV.

Sign Up Sheets

Sign-up sheets for winter boat storage, winterization of RV water systems, fall and spring site cleaning and monthly paying of seasonal campsites are at the office.

Boats Off Docks Schedule

Floating docks need to be vacated by Sunday, September 20. Please remember to take your lines and bumpers, as any items left behind will be considered abandoned. Winter storage boaters should place their boats close to Cottage Road or along the St. Thomas Moore boundary line. All other boat and utility trailers should be removed from the property by closing day.

Closing Up Checklist

- Winterize water system or sign up for winterization
- Leave anti-syphon valve
- Unplug from electric
- Take hose off camp water bib
- Disable golf cart or take it home
- Store kayaks etc. on site
- Lock RV and drop off key in office if you haven't already
- Remove any coverings on picnic table and clean surface of table

Invoices For Electric And Winter Storage

Invoices for electric overages for August and winter storage for the 2020-2021 winter season are available at the campground office again this weekend. Winter storage payments are due in our office by October 12. If you don't intend to leave your RV on site, please let us know. If you pull your RV off and leave personal items, you will be charged a storage fee of \$125 + tax for items left on site.

Winterization Of Water Systems

Campers having Laurel Lock staff winterize their RVs water system should do the following: Make sure the office has a key to one of your doors and any outside showers or faucets. Leave slide outs out until after winterization is complete (we will call you after it's done.) Leave the RV instruction booklet on the kitchen table.
