## Trash Talk

**Recycling:** Please flatten all cardboard for the blue single-stream recycling dumpster. Do not place plastic bags in the dumpster. The recycling people throw these into the trash pile which defeats the process of recycling.

**Trash:** The 3 green 6-yard dumpsters are for household trash generated at camp only. Large items no longer wanted must be taken home with you for disposal.

## Boat, Dock & Cart Payments

Boat, dock, golf cart and site cleaning payments are due in our office by May 15th. There is no grace period on these payments so make sure your payment is received in our office by the 15<sup>th</sup> to avoid a late fee. Dock slip holders who don't pay slip fees will not have their slips held for them.

## Paddlers

All campers with kayaks, canoes or SUPs must register their vessels in the camp office, pay a fee and receive a numbered sticker to place on the port side of the vessel. This rule pertains to all boats or boards regardless of where they are stored on the property. If you are the owner of the 2 small blue kayaks on the rack by the campers beach, please register your kayaks in the office.

## Trailer For Sale On Site

The 38' trailer on site 55 is for sale and comes with a deck. ## Golf Carts

Insurance paperwork is needed in our office for every golf cart used on campground property. If you haven't already turned in your golf cart insurance, please know the paper you provide from your insurance company needs to proclaim the following: Your name(s), the dates of coverage, a minimum of \$100,000 liability coverage and that the policy expressly denotes that it is for a golf cart. Digital proof is not acceptable - please provide paper copies. Also, 4" numbers (your site number) must be prominently displayed either on both sides of your cart, or front and back. Please make sure any of your guests using your golf cart abide by our rules.

## Keys

Two small sets of keys were found at the campground at the end of last season. Take a look on our bulletin board if you lost keys. Also, the campground has a key safe for spare keys for seasonal campers. We will never access a camper's key without express permission. But if you have an alarm go off, or you got locked out, its good to have a spare key handy. If you haven't already provided a key to your RV, please do so.

## Quiet Time

Please be respectful of your neighbors and adhere to our quiet time rules: 10 pm to 8 am on weekdays and 11 pm to 8 am on weekends and holidays.
