30-Yard Dumpster

The 30-yard dumpster located near the rear of the rec hall is for campers to dispose of unwanted items. When the dumpster is full, it will be removed. Please note some items are not permitted in the dumpster. A list of forbidden items is on the front.

Recycling Notes

Our blue recycling dumpster is for recycling flattened cardboard, paper, plastic containers with 1 – 7 markings, glass containers, books and foil. What is not allowed is Styrofoam, plastic film (as in bags or wrappings), or garbage. Please don't throw plastic bags of recyclables in the recycling dumpster as the recyclers will toss them in the garbage. Please use the green trash cans to the right of the blue dumpster for 5 cent deposit containers such as beer and soda cans and plastic water bottles.

Adult Rec Hall

The adult rec hall is for use by our campers over the age of 18 for internet access or small gatherings. If you plan to have a gathering, please reserve it with the office. We ask that the room be left in its original condition.
