Guest Fees

As a reminder, all people visiting your site that are not registered to your site must pay guest fees. \$8 for a day visit and \$15 for an overnight stay. Weekend visitors pay \$30 for Friday to Sunday. Day visitors need to exit camp by quiet time (10 pm during the week and 11 pm on weekends and holidays).

Camper Keys

Does the office have a key to your RV? The camp office has a key safe to keep keys for campers if they misplace or forget their keys or if there is an emergency when they are not at camp. Many campers who keep a key with us have been thankful that they were able to get into their rig when their key was not available. We have also been able to circumvent damage to RV's when a pipe breaks or an alarm was going off. Please know we will never use your key to access your RV unless your RV is in imminent danger, we've gotten your permission to rectify a problem or you request the key.
