## Carts Stick To Roads

Please only drive your carts on camp roads. If you are accessing the boat field, drive along the first base line or use the boat field access road. When there is heavy rainfall, the boat field can get soft and it may result in ruts.

## Fire Hazard

As you may know, the chance for fire is high and the DEEP has issued a red (or high) alert for forest fire danger in the state. If choosing to have a fire in your campsite fireplace, please follow these guidelines: Have a water source near the firepit, keep all fires to a reasonable size and extinguish all coals when unattended.

## Docks

All docks are ready for occupancy this weekend. Please confirm your slip location with the office before tying up. If you are new to LLC docks or are unsure how to secure your boat to the dock, please call Tom Hornat for assistance prior to tying up. He can be reached at 860-965-1453. Do not attach any hardware to the docks.

## LLC Stickers

All Paddleboats, SUPs and boat trailers on the property are required to have a LLC sticker issued from our office attached to them. Paddle boats and SUPs should place the stickers on the front, left side of the vessel and boat trailers should place the sticker on the tongue of the trailer.

The 2020 29' Crossroads Sunset RV on site #70 is for sale. This RV comes with a golf cart, deck, shed, hard awning, gazebo, gas fireplace and too many items to mention here. ## Propane Tank Filling
