All Boaters

Please combine common sense with courtesy when entering and exiting our docks. Please maintain "idle" or no wake speed within 100 feet of docks and swim areas (or 200 feet from shore). Approach and depart your docks perpendicular to shore rather than parallel. Also, one half hour before sunset motor boat speed is not to exceed 6 mph. If Gardner Lake police are present, they will ticket you for exceeding the speed limit.

Goose Poop

For the next month or so geese will be trying to come ashore at LLC to eat and poop. We have fencing and scented deterrents set up. Please don't disturb these deterrents. You may move the fencing to launch paddle-boats but please put them back after.

Annual Fish Spawn & Die

Dead fish washing up on our shore is a natural occurrence each season. Please place dead fish in the (dead fish container labeled at the campers' beach or call the office for removal. Please do not "help us" by disposing dead fish in gray trash cans.
