Campground Wifi

We are aware that there continues to be issues with Wifi access to individual sites throughout the campground. We have been researching various options as we understand how important internet access has become to our campers. Unfortunately, there are various rumors and half truths circulating throughout our community. We ended 2022 and started 2023 with the representation from Frontier that additional ports would be available for campers to get Wifi in the spring. However, this spring they have refused to use those available ports to allow campers Wifi access while trying to force us into a 3-year contract to install to new sites. We are planning to meet with multiple potential providers to determine the best way to get Wifi access throughout the campground. Thank you for your patience and understanding. We will provide updates in *The Chatter* as this develops. In the interim, Wifi continues to be available in and around the rec hall. Also please keep in mind that when trying to persuade Frontier installers to provide service to you, that often involves taking away access to your neighbors.

10 MPH

For the safety of our children and all our campers the speed limit throughout the campground is 10 mph. This speed limit pertains to cars, carts and bikes. **Please remember to always come to a full and complete stop at the stop sign regardless of whether the store is open or not.** This slows traffic at the busiest area of camp. Also remember to take special care at intersections.

Gardner Lake Water Temperature 68 °

Each week the lake water temperature is consistently taken on the bottom of the lake at the end of the F dock.

Stickers, Tags and Stickers

Boat trailers, paddleboats and SUPs at the campground (regardless of where they are kept) are to have an LLC sticker attached to them. If you have a boat trailer or a paddle vessel without a sticker you are in violation of our policy. Please check into the office to get your sticker. If you're not showing your hang tag on your car's rear-view mirror, we will be stopping you at the camp store/office. Any new campers who have not received their hang tag should check into the office to receive your tags.
