In An Emergency

If you or someone you know is having an emergency health situation at camp, call 911 and tell them you're at Laurel Lock Campground, 15 Cottage Road in Oakdale, Connecticut. If the camp office is open, alert the office and have someone drive a car or cart to the entrance to show ambulance driver the way to the ailing person. If the ambulance has lights and sirens going, ask them to quiet them so as not to disturb the entire campground. If you are a bystander, ask if you can help initially, but please give emergency personnel room to do their jobs.
