Tips From Teresa of Road Tech RV

Some antifreeze products for RVs contain alcohol which has been known to dry out rubber fittings in camper toilets. These products are usually the less expensive antifreeze products on the market. (Laurel Lock uses the pink food-grade antifreeze that does not contain alcohol.) Make sure you purchase the pink, non-alcohol antifreeze when preparing for your water system winterization or check with whomever you hire to make sure they are using the good stuff.
